**12-248-1 Chapter 1: Creation of Fund**

**12-248-1-1**

There is hereby created a fund to be known as the High Tech Crime Unit Fund. Said Fund shall be funded by receipt of grant funds from the State of Indiana.

**12-248-2 Chapter 2: Purpose**

**12-248-2-1**

The purpose of the Fund is to be used for only the following reasons as set forth in Indiana Code § 33-39-8-7:

- A. To enhance the ability of the Allen County prosecuting attorneys in investigating, collecting evidence, and prosecuting high tech crime;
- B. To provide personnel costs, training technical assistance, and technical support to the Office of the Allen County Prosecuting Attorney's High Tech Crime Unit;

**12-248-3 Chapter 3: Administration of Funds**

**12-248-3-1**

This fund shall be administered by the Office of the Allen County Prosecuting Attorney. The funds shall be disbursed with appropriation. No funds from other sources shall be deposited in the Fund, except any required matching funds, if applicable. All expenditure of funds shall be approved by the Office of the Allen County Prosecuting Attorney with any and all claims to be paid from the County's High Tech Crimes Unit Fund. Any unused funds shall be paid back to the Indiana State Treasury when required

**12-248-4 Chapter 4: Non-Investment and Non-Reversion**

**12-248-4-1**

All amounts placed in the Fund shall not be invested. Said funds shall not revert to the General fund at the end of the year.
