WHEREAS, Allen County Code Title 12 (Financial) – Article 74 (Youth Services Central Placement Fund) was passed by the Board of Commissioners on October 20, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners would like to modify Allen County Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained that:

Section 1. Allen County Code Title 12 (Financial) - Article 74 (Youth Services Central Placement Fund) shall be amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE 74

YOUTH SERVICES CENTER PLACEMENT FUND

12-74-1 Chapter 1: Creation of Fund

12-74-1-1

There is hereby authorized and created a fund to be known as the “Youth Services Center Placement Fund” (the “Fund”). ~~Said fund shall be funded by the receipt of per diem placement fees for juveniles detained at the Youth Services Center. Effective January 1, 2022, no additional revenue shall be received in this fund.~~

12-74-2 Chapter 2: Purpose

12-74-2-1

The purpose of this Fund will be to provide a holding account for per diem ~~detention-placement~~ fees ~~assessed to juveniles, their parents or guardians, for juveniles received from the Indiana Department Child Services for juveniles placed~~ detained at the Youth Services Center.

12-74-3 Chapter 3: Administration of Funds

12-74-3-1

This fund shall be administered by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Allen. Said Fund shall be appropriated in accordance with the general rules to which others funds of the County are subject, ~~but shall be spent in accordance with the following rules:~~

~~A. One half (1/2) of any fees collected shall be deposited to the Allen County General Fund on a daily basis.~~

~~B. The remaining monies shall be deposited in the Fund and may be spent only for special purposes at the Youth Services Center.~~

12-74-4 Chapter 4: Applicability

~~This Ordinance applies to a juvenile, and the parent, legal custodian, or guardian of a juvenile detained at the Youth Services Center under the delinquency jurisdiction of the Allen Superior Court, pursuant to a written placement contract between the County and any other Indiana county, or pursuant to any other agreement or understanding between the County and any other federal, state, or local governmental unit or agency.~~

12-74-5 Chapter 5: Fee Reimbursement Schedule

12-74-5-1

~~The following schedule of fees is established:~~

~~A. Per diem for Allen County Resident: \$25/day~~

~~B. Per diem for Resident of a county with a Written placement contract with Allen County \$100/day~~

~~C. Per diem for all others \$150/day~~

~~The Judge of the Allen Superior Court having primary jurisdiction over the Youth Services Center shall have the discretion to waive or reduce fees for reasons of indigency or equity.~~

12-74-6 Chapter 6: Investment and Non-Reversion

12-74-6-1

All amounts placed in the Fund shall be invested and reinvested pursuant to the standard procedures followed by the County and interest earned shall be credited to the account. Said funds shall not revert to the County's general fund at the end of the year. Interest earned by the Fund shall be deposited into same to help defray expense incurred by said Fund.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective as of the date of passage.
