**Building Department — 449-7131**

- Abandoned/unsecured/unsafe buildings
- Landlord/tenant responsibilities

**Health Department — 449-7561**

- Air quality (dust, smoke, indoor air issues)
- Mobile home parks
- Sewage/septic concerns — **449-7530**
- Vector Control (environmental issues) — **449-7459**
  - Mosquitoes, breeding sites, standing water
  - Cockroaches, fleas, ticks, dead birds, rodents
  - Garbage, trash
  - Noxious odors
  - Discarded refrigerators/freezers
  - Lead & lead paint concerns
  - Adult endangerment/unsafe living conditions

**Highway Department — 449-7369**

- Snow removal, potholes
  - North Barn — **449-4781**
  - South Barn — **449-4791**
- Problems with culverts or bridges
- Street surface problems
- Drainage problems on road right-of-way

**Homeland Security - 449-4663**

- Emergency preparedness & planning
- Reporting suspicious activity

**Joint Department of Planning Services — 449-7607**

- Home business complaints
- Unlicensed vehicles on property

**Dept. of Environmental Management — 449-7265**

- Illegal dumping
- Open burning
- Household hazardous waste disposal

**Sheriff — 449-3000 (Emergencies — 9-1-1)**

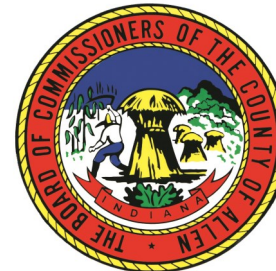
- Suspicious vehicles
