

ALLEN COUNTY CODE TITLE 1 GENERAL PROVISIONS

ARTICLE 11 U.S. SAVINGS BOND PURCHASE PROGRAM

1-11-1 Chapter 1: Eligibility

1-11-1-1 Eligibility

The individuals who are eligible to participate hereunder are all employees of Allen County who are covered or who are eligible to be covered under the objectives for said company.

1-11-1-2 Termination of Eligibility

If a participant ceases to be an employee, or ceases to otherwise be covered, or eligible to be covered, under the County's Health and Welfare Plan, participating in this plan will automatically terminate.

1-11-2 Chapter 2: Benefits

The 1990 Indiana General Assemble enacted H.E.A. 1240/Public Law 10 which requires each county executive to either join with one or more counties or designate itself as a single county district. The Board of Commissioners for the Count of Allen have determined that it would be in the best interest for the citizens of Allen County to establish itself a single county solid waste district.

1-11-3 Chapter 3: Amendment and Termination

1-11-3-1

The Board of Commissioners of the County may amend or terminate this Plan at any time by a duly adopted resolution.

1-11-3-2

All additional withholdings shall cease from the day the plan is terminated, unless otherwise provided by the Board of Commissioners or other provision of this Plan.

1-11-4 Chapter 4: Miscellaneous

1-11-4-1

This option to participate in the purchase of U.S. Savings Bonds shall not be deemed to constitute a contract between the County and any participant or to be a consideration or inducement for the employment of any participant or employee. Nothing contained in this option shall be deemed to give any participant or employee the right to be retained in the service of the County or to interfere with the right of the County to discharge any participant or employee regardless of the effect which said discharge will have upon him as a participant in this option.

1-11-4-2

This option shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Indiana to the extent not pre-empted by federal law.

1-11-5 Chapter 5: Execution
