

ALLEN COUNTY CODE TITLE 1 GENERAL PROVISIONS

ARTICLE 1 HOME RULE

1-1-1 Chapter 1: Quorum

1-1-1-1

A majority of the elected members of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Allen constitutes a quorum.

1-1-2 Chapter 2: Majority Vote

1-1-2-1

A majority vote is required to pass an ordinance pursuant the “Home Rule” powers.

1-1-3 Chapter 3: Adoption of Ordinances

1-1-3-1

An ordinance adopted pursuant to the “Home Rule” provisions is considered adopted when it is signed by the president of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Allen.

1-1-3-2

An ordinance prescribing a penalty for forfeiture for a violation must, before it takes effect, be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks, according to I.C. 5-3-1 et seq.

1-1-4 Chapter 4: Passage of Ordinance on day of Introduction

1-1-4-1

Unanimous consent of all Commissioners present is required to pass an Ordinance on the same day or at the same meeting at which it is introduced.

1-1-5 Chapter 5: Recording of Ordinances

1-1-5-1

Within a reasonable time after an Ordinance is adopted, the County Auditor shall record it in a book kept for that purpose. The record must include the signature of the president of the board of Commissioners of Allen County, and the attestation of the Auditor.
