**ARTICLE 174
GIS INFRASTRUCTURE FUND**

12-174-1 Chapter 1: Creation of Fund

12-174-1-1

There is hereby created a fund to be known as the GIS Infrastructure Fund. All funds received for deposit shall be transferred to and retained by the Allen County Treasurer.

12-174-2 Chapter 2: Purpose and Administration

12-174-2-1

The iMap System Management Board (“GIS Board”) shall use the Fund to pay obligations incurred for GIS infrastructure costs, with the approval of the GIS Board, without the necessity of appropriation by either the City or the County. The Fund shall be managed by Allen County Auditor.

12-174-3 Chapter 3: Definitions

12-174-3-1

“Infrastructure Costs” are defined as the following:

- (a) Costs associated with purchasing new hardware infrastructure devices or replacing existing hardware infrastructure devices as they become obsolete.
- (b) Costs associated with hardware maintenance contracts.
- (c) Costs associated with purchasing software or associated licensing for software related to the GIS infrastructure to accommodate future growth of the enterprise.
- (d) Costs associated with software maintenance of existing GIS software infrastructure.
- (e) Costs associated with acquiring color ortho-imagery and LiDAR data.
- (f) The cost of insuring the infrastructure.

12-174-4 Chapter 4: Perpetuation

12-174-4-1

The Fund shall be perpetual until terminated by a subsequent ordinance.

12-174-5 Chapter 5: Investment and Non-Reversion

12-174-5-1

All amounts placed in the fund shall be invested and reinvested pursuant to the standard procedure followed by the County. Amounts gained through investment shall not revert to the general fund of the County at the end of the fiscal or calendar year.

12-174-6 Chapter 6: Continuity of Ordinance

12-174-6-1

The express or implied repeal or amendment by this Ordinance of any other Ordinance or part of any other Ordinance does not affect any rights or liabilities accrued, penalties incurred, or procedures begun prior to the effective date of this Ordinance. Those rights, liabilities, and proceedings are continued, and penalties shall be imposed and enforced under the repealed or amended Ordinance as if this Ordinance had not been adopted.

12-174-7 Chapter 7: Conflict

12-174-7-1

No part of this Ordinance shall be interpreted to conflict with any local, state, or federal law, and all reasonable effects should be made to harmonize the same. Should any section or part thereof of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any other portion thereof, other than that portion declared to be invalid, any for this purpose the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

12-174-8 Chapter 8: Effective Date

12-174-8-1

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
