**ARTICLE 36
INFRACTION DEFERRED FUND**

12-36-1 Chapter 1: Creation of Fund

It is hereby authorized and crated a fund to be known as the "Infraction Deferred Fund" (the "Fund"). Said Fund shall be funded by the receipt of fees by the Allen County prosecuting Attorney in accordance with Indiana Code I.C. 32-4-3.2-1.

12-36-2 Chapter 2: Purpose

The purpose of the Fund shall be to provide for the funds necessary for the costs associated with the Infraction Deferred Service Program. Said funds shall be expended in accordance with the provisions of the above referenced State Statute.

12-36-3 Chapter 3: Administration of Funds

This fund shall be administered by the Allen County Prosecuting Attorney. Said fund shall be appropriated and spent in accordance with the general rules to which other funds be appropriated and spent in accordance with the general rules to which other funds are subject.

12-36-4 Chapter 4: Investment and Non-Reversion

All amounts placed in the fund shall be invested and reinvested pursuant to the standard procedures followed by the County, and said funds shall not revert to the County' general fund at the end of the year. Interest earned by the Fund, shall be deposited into same to help defray expenses incurred by said fund.

12-36-5 Chapter 5: Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective upon message.
