**ARTICLE 50
JUSTIN GRIFFIN MEMORIAL FUND**

12-50-1 Chapter 1: Creation of Fund

12-50-1-1

It is hereby authorized and created a fund to be known as the “Justin Griffin Memorial Fund” (the “Fund”). Said Fund shall be funded by the receipt of including, but not necessarily limited to, donations for programming at the South Probation Office.

12-50-2 Chapter 2: Purpose

12-50-2-1

This purpose of this Fund shall be to provide for assistance with programs which will positively impact the young people involved with the South Probation Team.

12-50-3 Chapter 3: Administration of Funds

12-50-3-1

This Fund shall be administered by the Family Relations Division of Allen County Superior Court. Said Fund shall be spent in accordance with the general rules to which other funds of the County are subject except, that appropriations shall not terminate at the end of the year but shall continue until the purpose for which they are made is accomplished or abandoned

12-50-4 Chapter 4: Investment and Non-Reversion

12-50-4-1

All amounts placed in the Fund shall be invested and reinvested pursuant to the standard procedures followed by the County and said funds shall not revert to the County’s General Fund at the end of the year. Interest earned shall be placed in the Fund.

12-50-5 Chapter 5: Effective Date

12-50-5-1

This ordinance shall be effective upon passage.

12-50-6 Chapter 6: Passage

12-50-6-1
