ARTICLE 53
COMMUNITY TRANSITION PROGRAM

12-53-1 Chapter 1: Creation of Fund

12-53-1-1

It is hereby authorized and created a fund to be known as the “Community Transition Program Fund” (the “Fund”). Said Fund shall be funded by the receipt of the per diem reimbursement from the State Department of Corrections and to hold all other funds collected by the program as established by I.C. 11-10-11.5.

12-53-2 Chapter 2: Purpose

12-53-2-1

The purpose of this Fund shall be to collect all fees and other reimbursements due and pay the expenses of the operation of the Community Transition Program.

12-53-3 Chapter 3: Administration of Funds

12-53-3-1

Said Fund shall be administered by the Community Corrections Board. Said fund shall be appropriated and spent in accordance with the general rules to which other funds are subject.

12-53-4 Chapter 4: Custodial Accounts

12-53-4-1

In accordance with I.C. 11-10-11.5-12, Community Corrections will establish a freestanding account for each prisoner who is transferred to the Community Transitions Program. Each account is a custodial account registered in the name of the actual Participant, with the Community Corrections Director acting as custodian. All money earned by a participant is required to be deposited into his/her account. Each prisoner shall provide his/her social security number and other information necessary to open said account. Each prisoner shall be solely responsible for the correctness of the information

and until supplied, there shall be no duty on Community Corrections to established said account. Disbursements shall be made in accordance with I.C. 11-10-11.15-12.

12-53-5 Chapter 5: Investment and Non-Reversion

12-53-5-1

All amounts placed in the Fund shall be invested and reinvested pursuant to the standard procedures followed by the County and interest earned shall be credited to the account. Said funds shall not revert to the County's general fund at the end of the year. Interest earned by the Fund shall be deposited into same to help defray expenses incurred by said Fund.

12-53-6 Chapter 6: Effective Date

12-53-6-1

This Ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 1999.

12-53-7 Chapter 7: Passage
