**ARTICLE 54
PRISONER REIMBURSEMENT FUND**

12-54-1 Chapter 1: Creation of Fund

12-54-1-1

It is hereby authorized and created a fund to be known as the “Prisoner Reimbursement Fund” (the “Fund”). Said Fund shall be funded by the receipt of fees to qualifying inmates of the Allen County Jail as outline in I.C. 36-2-13-15 and Allen County Code Title 8, Article 24.

12-54-2 Chapter 2: Purpose

12-54-2-1

The purpose of this Fund shall be to provide for the operation, construction, repair, remodeling, enlarging, and equipment of the Allen County Jail or a juvenile detention facility center to be operated under I.C. 31-31-8 or I.C. 31-31-9.

12-54-3 Chapter 3: Administration of Funds

12-54-3-1

The Fund shall be administered by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Allen. Said Fund shall be appropriated and spent in accordance with the general rules to which other funds of the County are subject except that appropriations shall not terminate at the end of the year but shall continue until the purpose for which they are made is accomplished or abandoned.

12-54-4 Chapter 4: Investment and Non-Reversion

12-54-4-1

All amounts placed in the Fund shall be invested and reinvested pursuant to the standard procedures followed by the County and said funds shall not revert to the County’s

General Fund at the end of the year. Any amount earned from the investment of amounts in the fund becomes part of the fund.

12-54-5 Chapter 5: Effective Date

12-54-5-1

This ordinance shall be effective upon passage.

12-54-6 Chapter 6: Passage
