**ARTICLE 59
PUBLIC DEFENDERS'
CAPITAL DEFENSE FUND**

12-59-1 Chapter 1: Creation of Fund

12-59-1-1

It is hereby authorized and created a fund to be known as the "Public Defenders' Capital Defense Fund." (the "Fund"). Said Fund shall be funded by the receipt of funds paid to the County arising out of Public Defender services in capital cases provided to surrounding counties.

12-59-2 Chapter 2: Purpose

12-59-2-1

The purpose of this Fund shall be to establish a method for handling funds paid to the County arising out of Public Defender services in capital cases provided to surrounding counties pursuant to agreement between the Allen Circuit Court and Circuit or Superior Courts for the surrounding Judicial Districts.

12-59-3 Chapter 3: Administration of Funds

12-59-3-1

When full-time Allen County Public Defenders are assigned capital cases from surrounding counties, with the concurrence of the Allen Circuit Court, funds paid for said services shall be deposited in the Public Defenders' Capital Defense Fund. Said fund shall be segregated for each Public Defender providing services. Funds received shall be paid to said Public Defenders, after receipt, less applicable withholdings and in accordance with the Salary Ordinance adopted by the Allen County Council.

12-59-4 Chapter 4: Investment and Non-Reversion

12-59-4-1

All amounts placed in the Fund shall be invested and reinvested pursuant to the standard procedures followed by the County and interest earned shall be credited to the account. Said funds shall not revert to the County's general fund at the end of the year. Interest earned by the Fund shall be deposited into same to help defray expenses incurred by said Fund.

12-59-5 Chapter 5: Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective on 4-19, 2000.
