**ARTICLE 73
ALLEN COUNTY JUVENILE JUSTICE
AND DETENTION CENTER PLACEMENT FUND**

12-73-1 Chapter 1: Creation of the Fund

12-73-1-1

There is hereby created a fund to be known as the “Allen County Juvenile Justice Center Placement Fund” (the “Fund”). Said Fund shall be funded by the receipt of per diem placement fees for juveniles (any person 18 years of age or younger, irrespective of legal status) detained at the Allen County Juvenile Justice Center.

12-73-2 Chapter 2: Purpose

12-73-2-1

The purpose of the Fund shall be to receive, hold, and account for those per diem detention fees assessed to juveniles, their parents, guardians or other responsible entity for juveniles detained at the Allen County Juvenile Justice Center.

12-73-3 Chapter 3: Administration of Funds

12-73-3-1

This fund shall be administered by the Judges of the Allen Superior Court having primary jurisdiction over the Allen County Juvenile Justice and Detention Center. Said Fund shall be appropriated in accordance with the general rules to which other funds of the County are subject, but shall be spent in accordance with the following rules:

- A. One-half (½) of any fees collected shall be deposited to the Allen County General Fund on a daily basis.
- B. The remaining monies shall be deposited in the Fund and may be spent only on motion of the Allen Superior Court Judge having primary jurisdiction over the Allen County Juvenile Justice and Detention Center and upon approval of the County Council for any 200, 300, or 400 series expenses at the Allen County Juvenile Justice and Detention Center.

12-73-4 Chapter 4: Applicability

12-73-4-1

This Ordinance applies to a juvenile, and a parent, legal custodian or guardian of a juvenile detained at the Allen County Juvenile Justice Center under the jurisdiction of the Allen Superior Court, or to such juvenile placed pursuant to a written placement contract with the County and any other Indiana county, or to a juvenile placed pursuant to any other agreement or understanding between the County and any other federal, state or local governmental unit or agency.

12-73-5 Chapter 5 Fee Reimbursement Schedule

12-73-5-1

The following schedule of fees is established:

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|---|-----------|
| A. Per diem for Allen County Resident placed in the temporary custody at the Allen County Juvenile Justice Center: | \$50/day |
| B. Per diem for Resident of a county with a written placement contract with: Allen County | \$100/day |
| C. Allen County Residents placed at Kryder House or Yoder House or pursuant to a placement contract with another county or governmental entity: | \$100/day |
| D. Per diem for all others: | \$150/day |

A judge of the Allen Superior Court having jurisdiction of a person temporarily placed in the Allen County Juvenile Justice Center shall have the discretion to waive or reduce the fees for reasons of indigence or equity. These fees shall not be charged or collected from a member of a family that makes that 150% of the federal income poverty level. This provision shall not relieve the responsibility of any other obligated entity to pay such fee pursuant to court order, placement contract or applicable law.

12-73-6 Chapter 6: Investment and Non-Reversion

12-73-6-1

All amounts placed in the Fund shall be invested and reinvested pursuant to the standard procedures followed by the County and interest earned shall be credited to the account. Said funds shall not revert to the County's general fund at the end of the year. Interest earned by the Fund shall be deposited into same to help defray expenses incurred by said Fund.
