ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES FUND**

12-89-1 Chapter 1: Creation of Fund

12-89-1-1

There is hereby created a fund to be known as the Adult Protective Services Fund. Said Fund is for the purpose of receiving and disbursing grant funds from the State of Indiana Division of Disability, Aging and Rehabilitative Services of the Family and Social Services Administration in order to provide Adult Protective Services to the citizens of Northeast Indiana, including Allen County, pursuant to I.C. 12-10-3, and by the provisions of the Older Americans Act, 42 U.S.C. 3058i, and through the State of Indiana pursuant to I.C. 12-9-5-1, and that the Prosecutor wishes to subcontract these services with the Mental Health Association in Allen County.

12-89-2 Chapter 2: Purpose

12-89-2-1

The purpose of the Fund shall be to allow for the disbursement of pass-through nt funds from the Allen County Prosecuting Attorney to the Mental Health Association of Allen County, for the provision of services for Adult Protective Services to the citizens of Allen County and Northeast Indiana.

12-89-3 Chapter 3: Administration of Funds

12-89-3-1

The funds shall be administered by the Prosecuting Attorney who shall separate, by line, grant funds received for specific purposes. The funds shall be disbursed by the Allen County Prosecuting Attorney without appropriation. The Prosecuting Attorney shall be responsible to ensure that funds within segregated lines are disbursed only for the purpose set forth in the grant.

12-89-4 Chapter 4: Investment and Non-Reversion

12—89-4-1

All amounts remaining in said Fund at the end of the year shall not revert but shall remain with said Fund for the purposes set forth above.
