CERTIFICATE OF TITLE INSPECTIONS  
BY ALLEN COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**8-10-1 Chapter 1**

**8-10-1-1**

Pursuant to Indiana Code 9-1-2-1, police officers of the Allen County are hereby authorized to inspect and verify the facts set forth in applications for certificates of title for motor vehicles, semi-trailers, watercraft, or recreational vehicles within the jurisdiction of the Allen County Police Department.

**8-10-1-2**

The Allen County Police Department is hereby authorized to charge a fee in the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each vehicle or watercraft inspected to the owner of such vehicle or watercraft for the inspection and verification of the facts set forth in the applications for such certification of title for such vehicle or watercraft.

**8-10-1-3**

The Allen County Police Department, or its duly authorized representative who shall be selected by the Sheriff of Allen County, is authorized to collect such fees and shall remit such fees at least monthly to the Allen County Auditor. A receipt for the certificate of title inspection fee by the Sheriff or other persons acting for the Sheriff shall be given to the owner paying such fee with a duplicate copy of such form retained by the Allen County Police Department.

**8-10-1-4**

The Allen County Police Department Certificate of Title Registration fees shall be receipted by the Allen County Auditor for deposit in the Allen County Police account known hereby as the "Certificate of Title Inspection Account" and such fees may be expended by the Sheriff of Allen County for any Department purpose reasonably related to the performance of such inspection services. All expenditures from said "Certificate of Title Inspection Account" shall be processed, appropriated, and allowed in the same manner as other claims of the County of Allen.
