**ARTICLE 4
ALLEN COUNTY SHERIFF'S RESERVE**

8-4-1 Chapter 1: Establishment and Administration

8-4-1-1 Creation of Reserve

Pursuant to I.C. 1971, 19-1-17-5, there is hereby created the Allen County Sheriff's Reserves.

8-4-1-2 Number

The number of police reserves shall be limited to 300 members.

8-4-1-3 Appointment of Members

All members of the police reserves shall be appointed by the same authority that appoints the regular members of the Allen County Police Department.

8-4-1-4 Authority

Police reserves may not be members of the regular Allen County Police Force, but shall have all the same police powers of such members except as limited by the rules of the Allen County Police Department. The Allen County Police Department is hereby specifically authorized to adopt rules to limit the authority of the police reserves of Allen County.

8-4-1-5 Participation in Pension

Police reserves may not participate in the pension program provided for regular members of the Allen County Police Department.

8-4-2 Chapter 2: Training

No individual shall be appointed to the Allen County Sheriff's Reserves until he has completed the training and probationary period specified by the rules to be enacted of the Allen County Police Department.

8-4-3 Chapter 3: Discretionary Service

Each duly appointed member of the Allen County Sheriff's Reserves shall serve at the discretion of the duly elected and qualified Sheriff of Allen County.
